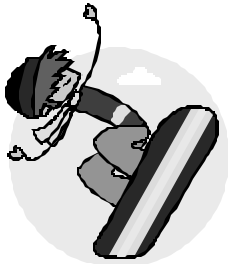
Who: Junior High Youth Group students and friends.

Where:

We will be staying at Incline Village Presbyterian Church on the north shore of Lake Tahoe. This has been our home-base for the past 3 Junior High Snow Trips, so we've got it down to a science. The church has great facilities: a large meeting room, separate sleeping rooms for boys and girls, and a kitchen. Another great feature is that they are located just around the corner from Diamond Peak Ski Resort. On Saturday, we will snowboard, ski, and hang-out at Diamond Peak.

How to sign up:

1. Fill out the '05-'06 Student Ministries Permission Form.
2. Write a check to SPC or call Taylor to ask about scholarships.
3. Drop off the above items at the church office, send them to church (attn: Taylor), or give them to Taylor in person.

Why:

The Junior High Snow Trip is not just about winter sports and conquering the mountain. Most importantly, it is an occasion for students to get a break from the everyday busyness of life and encounter the Lord. A Bible-based theme will be the foundation of the weekend getaway. Both mornings each person spends 25 minutes of solo time with their Bibles and God; both evenings the group gathers for a teaching session. The Snow Trip is a prime opportunity for students to build friendships amongst themselves and with the adult leaders. Of course, there is also the pure FUN element of the trip: snowball wars, adventures, laughs, chairlift shout-outs, and hot cocoa. This is a weekend that your child does not want to miss!

\$90 (non-refundable if we cannot fill the spot with a replacement).

Scholarship funds are available for families who need financial assistance.

Students are responsible for purchasing their lift tickets and 2 fast food meals on the road. Lift ticket prices: \$36 for a one-day teen (age 13-17) lift ticket, \$17 for a one-day child (age 12 & under) lift ticket (prices subject to change).

We suggest bringing about \$15 for the fast food meals.

Equipment:

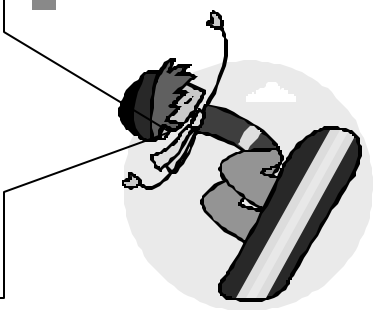
